

The Cycling of Matter

What is matter?

-matter makes up everything!

Matter "Cycles"



-matter isn't made or destroyed

-all matter changes form (and often returns)

Geosphere

What is the Geosphere?

<u>Geo</u> - the Greek word for "ground"

-includes all <u>rocks</u> and <u>minerals</u> on Earth from boulders to sand

-the geosphere does not contain any <u>living things</u>

Biosphere

What is the Biosphere?

Bio - the Greek word for "life"

-the biosphere is made up of all living things (and the only sphere with living things in it)

<u>Biome</u> - a region with similar plants, animals, terrain and climate Examples: tundra, forest, desert, etc

Hydrosphere

What is the Hydrosphere?

Hydro - Greek word for "water"

-all water on the planet is part of the hydrosphere

-includes any body of water: <u>lakes</u>, <u>rivers</u>, and <u>oceans</u>

-even includes <u>frozen water</u> like <u>glaciers</u>

Atmosphere

What is the Atmosphere?

Atmos - Greek word for "air"

- -contains all the <u>gases</u> on our planet
- -there are <u>five layers</u> of the atmosphere (you don't need to memorize the names of the five layers)
- -<u>rain</u> is part of the <u>hydrosphere</u> but <u>clouds</u> are part of the <u>atmosphere</u>
